Entry Requirements

Candidates will be required for interview. Applicants should be at least 18 years of age (at the discretion of the Program Co-ordinator) and be able to participate in adult group environments.

Extra Requirements

Must complete a Language, Literacy and Numeracy assessment and pre-training review.

Become a skilled operator in digital video & online content creation, or a skilled assistant in digital distribution services.

This entry level program will teach you how to work effectively in the creative arts industry, as well as offering you a range of electives which include digital video production and distribution, interactive simulations, interactive web based content and authoring, games design (UDK and Unity) 2D and 3D digital animation (Autodesk 3D s Max), electronic field production (EFP) and digital video compositing and effects.

This qualification reflects the role of a skilled operator in digital video distribution systems and online interactive content creation, or a skilled assistant in digital production services who applies a broad range of competencies in a varied work context. The program is aimed at digital producers of short stories of community interest and cultural awareness. This may also lead to digital instructional design in an education field for school based learning or authoring to school web portals.
